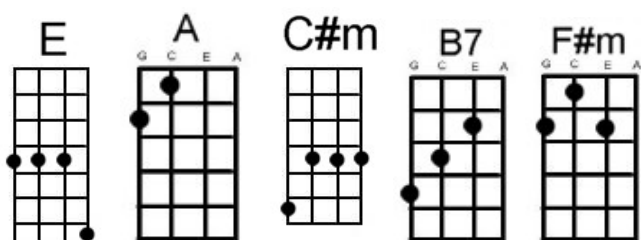


# The Auld Triangle      Dubliners
