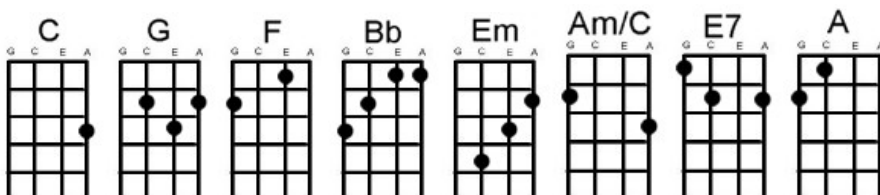
[C] Mommy, mommy, come and see oh [Bb] mommy hurry, [C] do
