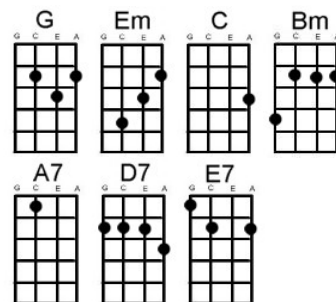


# Crocodile Rock Elton John
