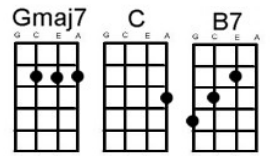


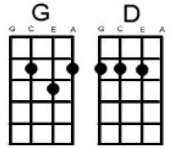

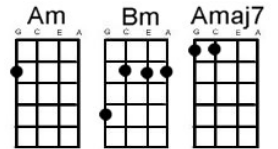


[Gmaj7] She looks in the mirror and stares at the wrinkles that

As [C] something comes into her mind



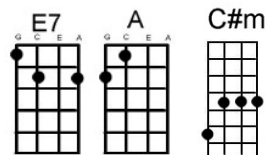
Slowly starts dancing re[G]memb'ring her girlhood
