

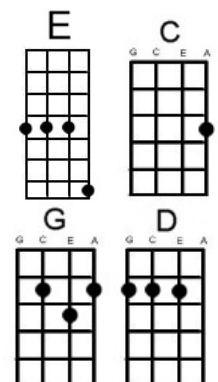
I'm Straight Jonathan Richman and the Modern Lovers
