Intro: Low G needed for pick

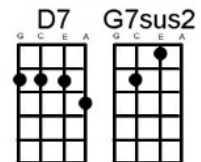

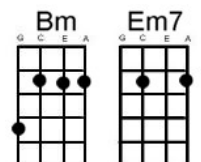
[C] Seven lonely [Csus4] days and a [C] dozen towns a [Csus4]go

 [D] To let you go never [D7] knowing what went [G7sus2] wrong $\frac{3}{4}$ [Fmaj7] x2

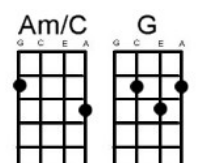
