

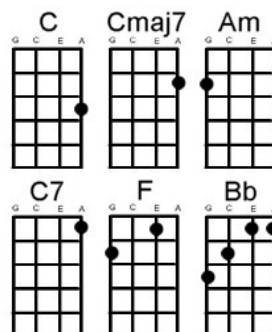

[Dm] No sign of love behind the tears cried for [A] no one

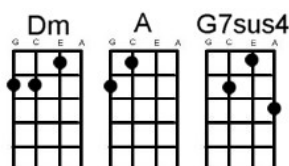
[Dm] A love that should have lasted years [G7sus4] [G7]

[Dm] No sign of love behind the tears cried for [A] no one

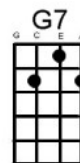
[Dm] A love that should have lasted years [G7sus4] [G7]

To get more bass line emphasis when playing with low G tuning use C: G5C0E0A3 Cmaj7:G4C0E0A2 and C7:G3C0E0A1
